HORIZON GOLF SCRAMBLE A SUCCESS!

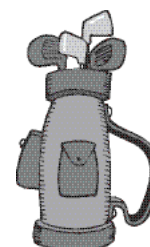

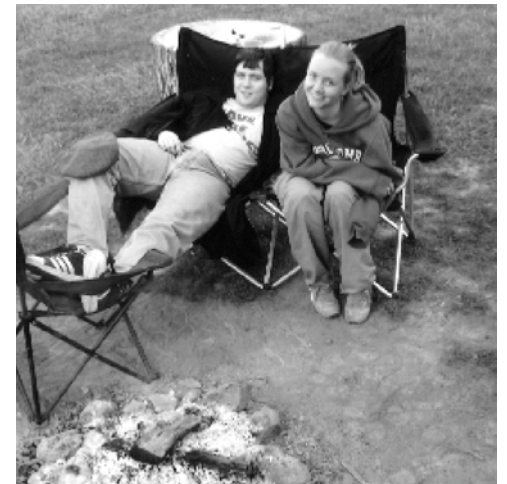

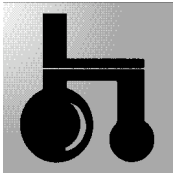


FALL WEEKEND CAMP
